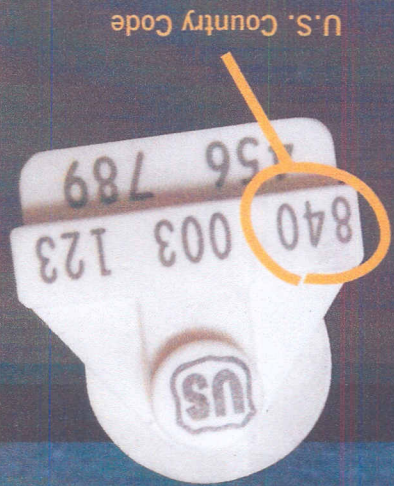
By choosing **840 eartags**, you will be able to take advantage of all the opportunities that hinge on the **official** identification of your cattle, including:

## What is an 840 eartag?

840 eartags may be visual-only or include radio frequency technology. These tags use a standardized 15-digit numbering system to create the official animal identification number (AIN). The first three digits (840) represent the U.S. country code. The AIN stays with the animal throughout its life. Visual-only eartags and RFID panel tags not only include the 840 AIN, but they also include a space where producers can add their own herd management number.
